To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Joseph Kliegl, a citizen of the United States of America and resident of Queens Village, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Spotlight, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof, wherein:

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a spotlight, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, omitting the lower portion of the stand;

Fig. 3 is a rear elevational view with the stand partly broken away; and

Fig. 4 is a view in perspective of the entire spotlight and its stand.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a spotlight, substantially as shown and described.
